

## 2016 Youth Ocean Conservation Film Competition Rules and Submission Information

The 2016 Youth Ocean Conservation Film Competition is designed to serve as a platform for students in grades preschool – college to create video messages about relevant ocean conservation issues.

### Contest rules:

- Videos submitted must be created by students in grades preschool – college.
- Videos must not exceed 3 minutes in length.
- Video focus should be on an ocean conservation topic/issue/project.
- Use of copyrighted music and materials is prohibited.
- Videos can be submitted by both individuals and groups.
- Video submissions must be received by 11:59 PM Eastern Standard Time on Monday, October, 31, 2016 in order to be eligible for the competition.

### Submission instructions:

In order to submit your video for this competition, create an account on YouTube, and upload your video. Once your video is successfully uploaded, complete the Youth Ocean Conservation Film Competition online entry form with the required information. When completing this form, you will be asked for the link to your video, which you can find by opening your video on YouTube and clicking on the “Share” feature at the bottom of the video.
